There are 17 Universities of Applied Sciences (UAS) in Bavaria

Neuschwanstein Castle, the „Oktoberfest“, FC Bayern-Munich, BMW – people all over the world associate these names with Bavaria. The Free State of Bavaria has lots of attractions, both culturally and due to the region’s appealing natural setting in southern Germany. At the same time, it is also one of Europe’s leading centres for science and technology, so much so that Bill Gates termed Bavaria a „High-Tech Mecca“, where innovative technology such as the MP3-Player, was developed.

Innovative, international, renowned: these adjectives also describe the institutions of higher education in Bavaria. The universities enjoy an excellent reputation and are continually given top ranking positions. Their highly practical orientation is another reason why this type of university has become so attractive. In the required practical semester, students gain valuable project-related work experience. The courses of studies are tightly organised and allow students to move swiftly and efficiently through.

The UAS provide a wide spectrum of programmes, mainly in the fields of Economics, Engineering, Social Work, and Design. A variety of applied research is being done in all of these areas.

A Bachelor’s Degree programme with an integrated practical semester requires seven semesters to complete, the following Master’s Degree course three semesters. In cooperation with German and foreign universities, it is possible to continue studying towards a PhD.

You will find a remarkable number of degree programmes entirely in the English language, although many courses of study are, of course, taught in German. Therefore, in order to study successfully, a good knowledge of German is required for university acceptance. Many universities offer DSH-courses, the TestDAF-Examination and German as a Foreign Language classes throughout the semester. A relatively low tuition fee must be paid (100 to 500 euros/semester, depending on the university) as the UAS are publicly financed.

With numerous international partner universities and students from almost all over the world, the UAS have an international perspective. Foreign students enjoy being in Bavaria, a safe place to live with excellent medical and health care and a wide variety of leisure activities.

Orientation events, language, sport and cultural programmes, the opportunity to live in a student residence and tutorials are some of the countless advantages that help international students achieve their academic goals successfully. The most important contact for foreign students is the International Office.
