Ranked 6th among the best German colleges and universities

Ansbach University of Applied Sciences has once again made it into the top 10 in this year's StudyCheck Awards and continues to improve its standing in Germany.

In the overall ranking of the most popular German colleges and universities, it jumped to 6th place (2025 – 8th place) out of 113. In the overall ranking in Bavaria, Ansbach University of Applied Sciences occupies an excellent 3rd place out of 19 colleges. The prestigious StudyCheck Awards recognise the best colleges and universities in Germany every year. The award is based on the opinions of students. The ranking is based on a total of 87,093 reviews submitted in the calendar year.

The ranking is based on a total of 87,093 reviews submitted to StudyCheck in the 2025 calendar year. Only colleges and universities that have received a minimum number of reviews are considered.

With a score of 9.22 out of a possible ten points, it is one of the top 10 universities in Germany. The score is based on star ratings and the recommendation rate. The already very good results from 2025 were improved upon once again: 99 per cent of students recommend Ansbach University of Applied Sciences and give it an average rating of 4.2 out of 5 stars. This result underlines the high quality and attractiveness of Ansbach University of Applied Sciences.

This is also confirmed by the student representatives: 'As the student council, we see the award as an expression of the high quality of the courses and the good cooperation between students and staff.'
